- Pencil box to hold all their supplies (.97 at Walmart)

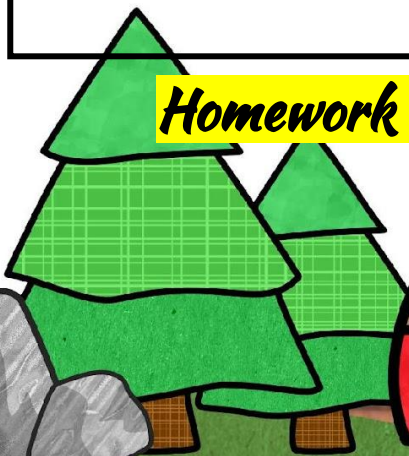
