Math: Adding Strategies

Vocab: Open Number Line, Doubles plus 1 fact, Doubles plus 2 fact

Your child will learn about strategies to use to add to 20. Some of the strategies include counting on, making 10, making doubles and adding 1 or 2 to doubles.

Language Arts

Spelling Words: spill, spin, grab, grass, drop, drip, hop, lot, two, move

Sight Words: jump, run, move, two

Vocab Words: physical, exercise, agree, exhausted, difficult

Words to Know Have your child show and tell the meaning of the words, and then write a sentence using each word.

Spelling/Phonics: beginning consonant blends Help your child identify the two beginning sounds that blend together in each spelling word. This week's phonics skill is beginning *r*- and *s*-blends, as in the words *stop*, *grin*, and *drip*. Help your child think of other words that begin with the same sounds.

Comprehension: key details

Have your child circle the sentence that tells a key detail about a picture. Then help your child identify more details in the picture.

Science-Light and Sound

Vocab Words: sound waves, vibrations, solid objects, emit, opaque, reflection, illuminated, translucent, transparent

Social Studies-Civics

Vocab words: respect, responsibility, equality, fairness. community, consensus, opinion
