Math-Add to 20

Vocab: Open Number Line, Doubles plus 1 fact, Doubles plus 2 fact

Your child will learn about strategies to use to add to 20. Some of the strategies include counting on, making 10, making doubles and adding 1 or 2 to doubles.

Language Arts

Spelling Words: clip, flip, slip, flag, black, plan Sight Words: be, pull, come, good, does, not, school, what, down, out, very, up Vocab Words: care, train, groom, companion, popular

Word Workout

- Words to Know Help your child use the words to tell a story about a special pet he or she would like.
- **Spelling/Phonics: beginning consonant blends** Help your child sort words with the *I*-blend. Help him or her write the spelling words and sort by beginning blends. This week's phonics skill is consonant *I*-blends in words such as **bl**ack, **clap, flag, play,** and **slip**. Then help your child add more words to each column.

Comprehension: key details

Science-Light and Sound

Vocab Words: sound waves, vibrations, solid objects, emit, opaque, reflection, illuminated, translucent, transparent

Social Studies-Civics

Vocab words: respect, responsibility, equality, fairness. community, consensus, opinion
