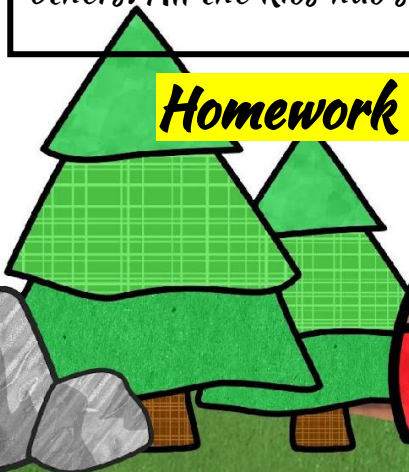
Classroom Volunteers do not need a card!!

Homework

- Read 10-15 minutes (can be adult or older sibling reading)
 - Practice Sight Words & Spelling Words (weekly test)
 - Optional—math only after first 3 homework assignments

Math—Add to 20 (We will be repeating this unit.)

Vocab: Open Number Line, Doubles plus 1 fact, Doubles plus 2 fact

Your child will learn about strategies to use to add to 20. Some of the strategies include counting on, making 10, making doubles and adding 1 or 2 to doubles.

Language Arts

Spelling Words: hop, top, log, hog, hot, lot, they, too

Sight Words: fun, they, make, too

Vocab Words: cooperate, relationship, deliver, chore, collect

Word Workout

- **Words to Know** Help your child use the words to tell a story about playing with friends.
- **Spelling/Phonics: short o** Help your child spell each word as you say it and identify the one letter that is in every in the word. This week's phonics skill is short o, as in *hop*, *log*, and *top*.

Comprehension: key details Help your child read sentences about a picture, and then choose the sentence that is true. (This activity was sent home in your child's folder.)

Science—Light and Sound

Vocab Words: sound waves, vibrations, solid objects, emit, opaque, reflection, illuminated, translucent, transparent

Social Studies—Civics

Vocab words: respect, responsibility, equality, fairness. community, consensus, opinion
